Notification about the results of the Competition

The Awarding Entity - Krakow Festival Office – with Supporting Entity (Co-organizer) Association of Polish Architects, Kraków Branch referred to in Article 123 section 1 of the Act of January 29, 2018. Public Procurement Law (vol. J. Of 2018 item 1986 as amended) hereinafter referred to as "the Act" and point 7.3.5. of Competition Regulations, informs that 5 Participants have been submitted in the Competition and the following prizes and distinctions have been granted (awarded to Studies at the 1st stage of the Competition):

THE FIRST PRIZE

According to point 1.5.3. of Competition Regulations cash prize of the gross amount of PLN 75,000 and invitation to negotiations through a single – source procedure regarding the subject matter of the Contract for comprehensive design documentation for the task named Centrum Literatury i Języka – Planeta Lem (Centre of Literature and Language – Planet Lem), and also – according to point 1.5.2. of Competition Regulations cash prize of the gross amount of PLN 25,000 receives:

Justification:

The First Prize was awarded for the creation of a flexible structure capable of accommodating various user requirements, the concept of the towers providing a clear mark in space, the proposed spatial code adequate to the works of Stanisław Lem, combining the geometry of the designed building with the existing Skład Solny (Salt Depot), coping skillfully with the limitations of the location resulting from the requirements of the zoning plan and the building and for technical and architectural solutions supporting energy efficiency.

The following Post-Competition Recommendations were drafted for Entry awarded First Prize:

- 1. Spatial connections relevant to the scenarios for the arrangement of both the spaces need introducing between the levels of Permanent (Main) Exhibition and the Multifunctional Space
- 2. The height of a section of the ground floor needs increasing to a value agreed with the Commissioning Party while working on the following phases of the design.
- 3. The number of posts and "cubes" needs reducing, especially in the Multifunctional Space, to allow greater flexibility of use.
- 4. The wave-form floor is not advisable in the Permanent (Main) Exhibition, as it does not result from the exhibition concept
- 5. The internal elements of the towers need removing / modifying wherever they interfere with the concept of the Permanent (Main) Exhibition.
