• Location: coordinates of the Adam Mickiewicz Monument on the Main Market Square – in the centre of the Old Town – 50°03′41″N and 19°56′16″E; near the south-eastern border of the City (the X district – Swoszowice) – location where the 50°N parallel and the 20°E meridian cross.

• South-North length: 18 km • West-East length: 31 km

• Highest point: 383 m MSL – Piłsudski Hill

• Lowest point: 188 m MSL – mouth of the Kościelnicki Stream into the Vistula River

• Average air temperature: 8.4°C; average temperature in January: -8.3°C, average temperature in July: 21.6°C (2006)

• Annual rainfall: 552 mm (2006)






